Paper Preparation Guidelines:

- * The paper should be at most 12-15 pages.
- * The abstract should address the following 5 points informally but clearly:
 1. **Problem:** What problem or project is tackled in the paper.
 2. **Scope:** How the problem/project is related to best practice
 3. **Motivation:** Where the problem arises, with whom etc.
 4. **Difficulty:** Why the problem cannot be solved trivially.
 5. **Solution:** What your solution is.

These criteria will be used by the program committee to rank the papers.
